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Christmas Snowflake Pattern



This is a very easy pattern for a basic crocheted snowflake. Once you get going they take about 10 minutes!

Materials:

Any white yarn will be fine. Make sure you use the hook size suggested by the ball band. We used Sirdar Blur with a 4.5mm hook.

Pattern:

Round 1: Chain 5, join into a circle using a slip stitch.

Round 2: Chain 5 (counts as 1 treble and 2 chains), *treble into ring, 2 chain, repeat from * 4 times, 6 trebles in total. Join to 3rd chain with a slip stitch.

Round 3: Chain 6, dc to top of treble on round 2. Repeat a further 5 times.

Round 4: Slip stitch 3 along chain 6 from round 3. *Chain 8, slip stitch to 4th chain from hook, chain 4, dc into next chain from round 3. Repeat from * 5 times more. Fasten off.

Finishing off:

Darn in ends. Lay the flakes on a towel and spray with water. Cover with another towel and leave them to dry. This will get them flat. Once dry, spray each one with hairspray to stiffen.

If you do hairspray them, please make sure that you don't hang them near any lights as hairspray is usually flammable!
